ORDER REINSTATING BRIEFING

This appeal was referred to the Pro Bono Committee of the State Bar of Nevada's Appellate Litigation Section, in conjunction with the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada, to evaluate whether appellant could benefit from the pro bono program. The Pro Bono Committee has filed a notice in this court stating that it has been unable to locate a volunteer attorney to represent appellant. Accordingly, this appeal is withdrawn from this court's pro bono program and shall proceed with appellant acting pro se.

Appellant shall have 60 days from the date of this order to file and serve either an opening brief that complies with NRAP 28 and NRAP 32, or the informal brief form for pro se parties provided by the clerk of this court. Respondent need not file a response to the brief unless ordered to do so by this court. NRAP 46A(c). This court generally will not grant relief without providing an opportunity to file a response. *Id.*
