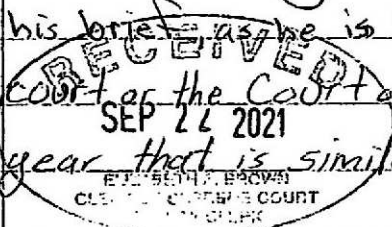
REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
