Pursuant to NRAP 14(f), Respondent/Cross-Appellant Lynda L. Hascheff files this response to the docketing statement filed by Appellant/Cross-Respondent Pierre A. Hascheff on April 5, 2021 to address certain misstatements and omissions made by Mr. Hascheff.

The parties' Marital Settlement Agreement ("MSA") provides that "[i]n the event [Mr. Hascheff] is sued for malpractice," Ms. Hascheff will indemnify him for "one half the costs of any defense and judgment." Contrary to the assertions in the docketing statement, Ms. Hascheff never "refuse[d] her specific indemnity obligations." Rather, she simply requested evidence that the amounts Mr. Hascheff demanded fell within the scope of the MSA language. Mr. Hascheff did not provide such evidence.

Moreover, in the docketing statement, Mr. Hascheff neglects to inform the Court that his OSC motion sought to have the district court hold Ms. Hascheff in contempt of court for allegedly violating the MSA, when she simply sought evidence that the money he demanded from her was actually her responsibility to pay.
