*ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER  
AND GRANTING STAY*


This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges the district court's decision to preside over indirect contempt proceedings despite petitioner's objection per NRS 22.030(3). Petitioner has also filed a motion to stay the district court contempt proceedings pending our consideration of this petition.


Having reviewed the petition and supporting documents, we conclude that an answer may assist this court in resolving the petition. Therefore, real parties in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 28 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. NRAP

21(b)(1). Petitioner shall have 14 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.

Further, we have reviewed the motion for stay, which is unopposed, under the NRAP 8(c) factors. We conclude that the factors weigh in favor of a stay. Therefore, we grant the motion and hereby stay the district court contempt proceedings in this matter pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
