

ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND RECALLING REMITTITUR

On January 24, 2022, the Court of Appeals entered an order of affirmance in this appeal. The remittitur issued on February 18, 2022. On March 16, 2022, this court returned appellant Mary-Anne Colt's petition for review as untimely submitted. *See* NRAP 40B(c). On March 31, 2022, Colt filed a "Motion for Recall of Denying Motion for Review" and submitted a petition for review and exhibits to the petition, including original photographs. The motion is construed as a motion to recall the remittitur. The documents attached to the motion to recall the remittitur demonstrate that on February 11, 2022, Colt provided her petition for review to a third-party carrier and contracted with them to deliver her petition within 3 days. Accordingly, we conclude the petition for review was timely dispatched, *see* NRAP 25(a)(2)(iii), NRAP 40B(c), and we grant the motion. The clerk of this court shall recall the remittitur and file the petition for review. The clerk of this court shall return, unfiled, the exhibits to the petition. *See generally* NRAP 40B(g) (providing that "review on the grant of a petition for review shall be conducted on the record and briefs previously filed in the Court of Appeals").

It is so ORDERED.
