(O) 1947A -

(appellants) Appellants/cross-respondents and respondents/cross-appellants (respondents) shall each have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a transcript request form. If no transcript is to be requested, appellants and respondents shall file and serve a certificate to that effect within the same time period. See NRAP 9(a). Further, appellants shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix on appeal. In preparing and assembling the appendix, counsel shall strictly comply with the provisions of NRAP 30. Respondents shall have 30 days from service of appellants' opening brief to file and serve a combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal. Appellants shall have 30 days from service of respondents' combined brief to file and serve a combined reply brief on appeal and answering brief on cross-appeal. Finally, respondents shall have 14 days from service of appellants' combined brief to file and serve a reply brief on cross-appeal, if deemed necessary. See NRAP 28.1.
