I. Additional Filings before the District Court.

NuVeda filed its Petition on or about April 14, 2021. <u>See</u> Dkt. 21-10775. The Petition was supported by an Appendix (Volumes I-VI). <u>See</u> Dkt. 21-10778 through Dkt. 21-10783. This Supplement is made as a result of the order filed on May 12, 2021 in this case. <u>See</u> Dkt. 21-13663. NuVeda provides the summary below and separately files Volumes VII-XV to its Appendix.

On July 29, 2020, NuVeda filed a motion to dismiss Shane Terry's claims and/or for summary judgment. <u>See</u> Appendix 0436-0447. This motion was supported by exhibits. <u>See id.</u> 0449-0764. Mr. Terry opposed the motion. <u>See id.</u> 0766-1033. NuVeda replied to Mr. Terry's opposition. <u>See id.</u> 1035-1046. The district court stayed the matter for ninety (90) days to provide Mr. Terry an opportunity to seek relief from the American Arbitration Association ("AAA"). See id. 1048-1056.²

On or about December 9, 2020, NuVeda filed a motion to enter an order on Mr. Terry's claims. See Appendix 0095-0160 (Dkt. 21-10779). Mr. Terry

Matters related to the impossibility of performance by CWNevada, LLC of its obligations to NuVeda and the priority of claims of other creditors are not relevant to the matters before this court. The order, however, was included in Appendix 0092-0095 (Exhibit 1 to Motion, Appendix 0085-0160).

opposed the motion. <u>See id.</u> 0162-0237 (Dkt. 21-10780). NuVeda replied to the opposition. <u>See id.</u> 0239-0299 (Dkt. 21-10781). At the hearing, the district court ordered Mr. Terry's attorney, Joe Coppedge, Esq., to supplement his opposition with a copy of the request for relief submitted to AAA, and the district court continued the matter to its chambers calendar. <u>See Appendix 1058-1059</u>. Mr. Coppedge filed his supplement on behalf of Mr. Terry. <u>See Appendix 0301-0381</u> (Dkt. 21-10782). After reviewing the supplement, the district court denied NuVeda's motion without prejudice and indicated to the parties that it desired to schedule an evidentiary hearing on the issue of rescission (since AAA no longer had jurisdiction). <u>See id.</u> 0383.³ The district court failed to explain how or why it had jurisdiction to decide the matter (when AAA determined that AAA did not).

On or about February 12, 2021, NuVeda filed a motion to stay the proceedings so that it could pursue a writ petition. <u>See id.</u> 0385-0407 (Dkt. 21-10783). NuVeda filed a supplement to its motion. <u>See Appendix 1061-1064</u>. NuVeda also filed a jury demand. <u>See id.</u> 1066-1067. Mr. Terry opposed the motion. <u>See id.</u> 1069-1140.⁴ NuVeda replied to the opposition. <u>See Appendix 1069-1140.</u>

0409-0425 (Dkt. 21-10783). The district court denied the stay, decided not to conduct an evidentiary hearing on rescission (because there were factual issues to be resolved by a jury), refused to apply the 5-year rule, and set the matter for trial.

See id. 0427-0428; 0430-0434.5

II. Conclusion

For the reasons set forth in the Petition, Appendix (Volumes I-VI), and this Supplement (including Volumes VII-XV to the Appendix), NuVeda seeks an order requiring the claims of Mr. Terry be dismissed and/or summary judgment granted.
