



Appellants filed a civil action against EPCC seeking, among other things, injunctive relief to enjoin for-profit rental use of units within the social club because such use jeopardizes the private social club's tax-exempt status. On December 15, 2020, the district court entered an Order Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Injunction Order"). The Injunction Order required EPCC to prohibit, prevent and enjoin all for-profit rental use of units within the social club including transient commercial use and long-term rental use of any unit. The Respondent appealed the Injunction Order. Pending its appeal, the Respondent moved the district court under NRAP 8(a)(1)(C) to stay or suspend the Injunction

Order pending resolution of its appeal. On March 15, 2021, the district court entered an Order 2 Granting Stay of Preliminary Injunction Pending Resolution of the Interlocutory Appeal ("Stay Order") staying the enforcement of the Injunction Order. The district court's Stay Order, if applied to both long-term and transient commercial use, dissolves the entire Injunction Order, so that EPCC would no longer be required to enjoin transient commercial use and long-term rental use of 6 Units, and thus, permits all for-profit rental use of units within EPCC to continue.

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
