(PROPOSED) ORDER RE WILLIS **DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO STRIKE** PLAINTIFF'S JURY DEMAND AS TO ITS CLAIMS AGAINST THE WILLIS **DEFENDANTS OR, IN THE** ALTERNATIVE, TO COMPEL **ARBITRATION**

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Defendants WILLIS OF ARIZONA, INC. AND WILLIS TOWERS WATSON INSURANCE SERVICES WEST, INC.'S MOTION TO STRIKE PLAINTIFF'S JURY DEMAND AS TO ITS CLAIMS AGAINST THE WILLIS DEFENDANTS OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO COMPEL ARBITRATION ("Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike") was fully briefed and, pursuant to Administrative Order 21-03, decided without oral argument. Having reviewed the Motion filed by Defendants on February 11, 2021, the Opposition filed by Plaintiff on February 25, 2021, and the Reply in support of the Motion filed on March 8, 2021, the Court DENIES the Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike.

On March 29, 2019 Defendants Willis of Arizona, Inc. and Willis Towers Watson Insurance Services West, Inc. (collectively, "Willis") presented a proposal to Hakkasan to procure various insurance policies for the 2019–20 policy term (the "Proposal"). The Proposal included a nine-page document entitled "Brokerage Terms, Conditions & Disclosures" (the "T&Cs"). Section 1.13 of the T&Cs reads as follows:

> **Dispute Resolution**. The parties agree to work in good faith to resolve any disputes arising out of or in connection with the services provided under these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures. If a dispute cannot be resolved it will be submitted to non-binding mediation to be conducted by Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Services (JAMS) before either party pursues other remedies hereunder. If the mediation does not resolve the dispute and a party or both parties wish to pursue other remedies, the parties agree that their legal dispute will be resolved without a jury trial and agree not to request or demand a jury trial. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the parties hereby irrevocably waive any right they may have to demand a jury trial.

> To the extent the foregoing jury trial waiver is not enforceable under the governing law, except as provided below, any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures which the parties are unable to resolve between themselves or through mediation as provided above, will be resolved by binding arbitration in the state as provided for in paragraph 14 below, or other mutually agreed location, before a panel of three arbitrators in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. . . .

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Willis contends that the foregoing section of the T&Cs precludes Hakkasan from trying its present claims for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations against Willis to a jury. Willis further contends that Hakkasan's claims against Willis in this case should be compelled to arbitration in accordance with the T&Cs if the jury waiver provision is not enforceable under Nevada law. In response, Hakkasan argues inter alia the T&Cs only govern Hakkasan's purchase of insurance through Willis, and Hakkasan's present tort claims do not "aris[e] out of or in connection with" that transaction. The Court agrees with Hakkasan and concludes that Hakkasan's present claims against Willis for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations are outside the scope of the Dispute Resolution clause in Section 1.13 of the T&Cs.

For the aforementioned reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike is DENIED.

- 9. A brief description of the nature of the action and result in the district court, including the type of judgment or order being appealed and the relief granted by the district court:

In the underlying action, Hakkasan has alleged that it "contracted with Willis to provide [insurance] brokerage and claims-handling services" and that Willis engaged in conduct that was, among other things, "in breach of contract" by allegedly notifying Hakkasan's insurer, prematurely, of an impending COVID-19-related insurance claim. Hakkasan further claims that Willis's conduct resulted in the insurer issuing a General Change Endorsement reflecting a \$1,500,000 sublimit for virus-related coverage under Hakkasan's \$350,000,000 per occurrence Commercial Property Surplus Lines insurance policy (the "Policy"), thereby depriving Hakkasan of the full policy limits for its alleged COVID-19 losses.

The parties' relationship is governed by a dispute resolution provision contained in the parties "Brokerage Terms, Conditions & Disclosures" (the "T&Cs"). The T&Cs contain, among other things, a mandatory "Dispute Resolution" provision in which the parties waived any right to

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a jury trial. To the extent the jury trial waiver is not enforceable under the governing law, the T&Cs require the parties to resolve their disputes by binding arbitration.

On February 11, 2021, Willis filed a Motion To Strike Plaintiff's Jury Demand As To Its Claims Against The Willis Defendants Or, In The Alternative, To Compel Arbitration (the "Motion to Strike"). After the parties' briefing on the Motion to Strike was completed, the district court chose not to hold a hearing and entered a minute order denying the Motion to Strike stating that "[i]ssues related to the proposal are distinct with those which remain at issue in this matter." Subsequently, on March 25, 2021, the district court executed an Order denying the Motion to Strike holding that "Hakkasan's present claims against Willis for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations are outside the scope of the Dispute Resolution clause in Section 1.13 of the T&Cs."

As such, Willis appeals the district court's order pursuant to NRS 38.247(1)(a).

10. Whether the case has previously been the subject of an appeal to or original writ proceeding in the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals and, if so, the caption and docket number of the prior proceeding:

Concurrently with the filing of this interlocutory appeal, and out of an abundance of caution, Willis is filing a Petition for Writ of Mandamus as to the district court's refusal to strike Hakkasan's jury demand. See Lowe Enterprises Residential Partners, L.P. v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court ex rel. Cty. of Clark, 118 Nev. 92, 97, 40 P.3d 405, 408 (2002) (concluding that "extraordinary review is available" when the district court denies a motion to strike a jury demand because "[i]f petitioners had to wait to challenge the district court's denial of their motion to strike the jury demand on appeal, petitioners would have too difficult a burden to meet upon appellate review").

Willis intends to file a motion to consolidate these proceedings forthwith.





Mr. Whitmire explained that the remaining portions are related to Endurance, the lead underwriting company; after significant meet-andconfers there was ultimately document production and haggling as to whether a 30(b)(6) witness would be produced by Endurance; they agreed to put up one recently; the cut-off is this week; parties agreed to a short extension of time; they are seeking 30 more days to complete the 30(b)(6) deposition; there are some deficiencies on document production and questions on the scope of redactions and relevancy; however, progress has been made on jurisdictional discovery and they do see a light at the end of the tunnel; Hakkasan is seeking a short addition of time, i.e. 30 days to complete 30(b)(6) depos and the Court may ultimately need to rule on the scope of production issues. Ms. Raschke advised they produced documents and made a corporate representative available for Sompo; they disagree that producing documents as to Endurance were necessary for jurisdictional discovery over Sompo; she does think there is a difference between what they are seeking with regards to jurisdictional discovery. COURT ORDERED, the request for a 30-day jurisdictional discovery extension is GRANTED on the deposition only; motion practice related to documents can be done any time. With regards to experts, parties advised they may have claims experts, damages experts, and possibly a bad faith expert as well. Colloquy regarding splitting / phasing discovery. Jury DEMANDED. Trial Setting Order will ISSUE. Parties declined a settlement conference at this time as premature.;

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Defendants WILLIS OF ARIZONA, INC. AND WILLIS TOWERS WATSON INSURANCE SERVICES WEST, INC.'S MOTION TO STRIKE PLAINTIFF'S JURY DEMAND AS TO ITS CLAIMS AGAINST THE WILLIS DEFENDANTS OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO COMPEL ARBITRATION ("Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike") was fully briefed and, pursuant to Administrative Order 21-03, decided without oral argument. Having reviewed the Motion filed by Defendants on February 11, 2021, the Opposition filed by Plaintiff on February 25, 2021, and the Reply in support of the Motion filed on March 8, 2021, the Court DENIES the Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike.

On March 29, 2019 Defendants Willis of Arizona, Inc. and Willis Towers Watson Insurance Services West, Inc. (collectively, "Willis") presented a proposal to Hakkasan to procure various insurance policies for the 2019–20 policy term (the "Proposal"). The Proposal included a nine-page document entitled "Brokerage Terms, Conditions & Disclosures" (the "T&Cs"). Section 1.13 of the T&Cs reads as follows:

> **Dispute Resolution**. The parties agree to work in good faith to resolve any disputes arising out of or in connection with the services provided under these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures. If a dispute cannot be resolved it will be submitted to non-binding mediation to be conducted by Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Services (JAMS) before either party pursues other remedies hereunder. If the mediation does not resolve the dispute and a party or both parties wish to pursue other remedies, the parties agree that their legal dispute will be resolved without a jury trial and agree not to request or demand a jury trial. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the parties hereby irrevocably waive any right they may have to demand a jury trial.

> To the extent the foregoing jury trial waiver is not enforceable under the governing law, except as provided below, any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures which the parties are unable to resolve between themselves or through mediation as provided above, will be resolved by binding arbitration in the state as provided for in paragraph 14 below, or other mutually agreed location, before a panel of three arbitrators in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. . . .

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Willis contends that the foregoing section of the T&Cs precludes Hakkasan from trying its present claims for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations against Willis to a jury. Willis further contends that Hakkasan's claims against Willis in this case should be compelled to arbitration in accordance with the T&Cs if the jury waiver provision is not enforceable under Nevada law. In response, Hakkasan argues inter alia the T&Cs only govern Hakkasan's purchase of insurance through Willis, and Hakkasan's present tort claims do not "aris[e] out of or in connection with" that transaction. The Court agrees with Hakkasan and concludes that Hakkasan's present claims against Willis for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations are outside the scope of the Dispute Resolution clause in Section 1.13 of the T&Cs.

For the aforementioned reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike is DENIED.

(collectively, "Willis") presented a proposal to Hakkasan to procure various insurance policies for the 2019–20 policy term (the "Proposal"). The Proposal included a nine-page document entitled "Brokerage Terms, Conditions & Disclosures" (the "T&Cs"). Section 1.13 of the T&Cs reads as follows:

> **Dispute Resolution**. The parties agree to work in good faith to resolve any disputes arising out of or in connection with the services provided under these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures. If a dispute cannot be resolved it will be submitted to non-binding mediation to be conducted by Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Services (JAMS) before either party pursues other remedies hereunder. If the mediation does not resolve the dispute and a party or both parties wish to pursue other remedies, the parties agree that their legal dispute will be resolved without a jury trial and agree not to request or demand a jury trial. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the parties hereby irrevocably waive any right they may have to demand a jury trial.

> To the extent the foregoing jury trial waiver is not enforceable under the governing law, except as provided below, any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Terms, Conditions & Disclosures which the parties are unable to resolve between themselves or through mediation as provided above, will be resolved by binding arbitration in the state as provided for in paragraph 14 below, or other mutually agreed location, before a panel of three arbitrators in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. . . .

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Willis contends that the foregoing section of the T&Cs precludes Hakkasan from trying its present claims for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations against Willis to a jury. Willis further contends that Hakkasan's claims against Willis in this case should be compelled to arbitration in accordance with the T&Cs if the jury waiver provision is not enforceable under Nevada law. In response, Hakkasan argues inter alia the T&Cs only govern Hakkasan's purchase of insurance through Willis, and Hakkasan's present tort claims do not "aris[e] out of or in connection with" that transaction. The Court agrees with Hakkasan and concludes that Hakkasan's present claims against Willis for civil conspiracy, constructive fraud, negligence, and intentional interference with contractual relations are outside the scope of the Dispute Resolution clause in Section 1.13 of the T&Cs.

For the aforementioned reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Willis Defendants' Motion to Strike is DENIED.
