ORDER DENYING MOTION

Appellant has filed a pro se motion to stay the issuance of the remittitur pending review in this court and the Nevada Supreme Court, and possibly the United States Supreme Court. Appellant timely filed a petition for rehearing in this court on June 18, 2021. The remittitur is thus stayed until disposition of the petition for rehearing. *See* NRAP 41(b)(1). Should the petition for rehearing be denied and should appellant file a timely petition for review in the Supreme Court of Nevada, the remittitur will be automatically stayed. *See* NRAP 41(b)(2). Accordingly, the motion is unnecessary with respect to the petition for rehearing and any petition for review. Further, the motion is premature with respect to any petition for a writ of certiorari. Should appellant file a petition for a writ of certiorari in the United States Supreme Court, he may file a motion to stay the issuance of the remittitur at that time.

It is so ORDERED.
