



*ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND REGARDING DEADLINE TO FILE  
OPENING BRIEF*

Court recorder Victoria Boyd has filed a motion for an extension of time to prepare the transcripts requested of her in this appeal. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. See NRAP 9(c)(4). Ms. Boyd shall have until August 23, 2021, to file the requested transcripts in the district court and deliver copies to the requesting party. See NRAP 9(c)(1)(A). Ms. Boyd shall have until that same date to file a notice with this court that the completed transcripts have been filed and delivered. The notice must comply with NRAP 9(c)(2). Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 9(c)(5); NRAP 13.

Given this extension of time to prepare transcripts, the time to file the opening brief and appendix is extended until October 22, 2021. Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions.
