Peitioner and Appellant Shawntina Palimore-Brown on March 31, 2021 filed a pro se Petition for Temporary Guardianship of Mae R. Brown in the Eighth Judicial District Court alleging abuse of her hospitalized mother and "rogue action" by her Brother Tyrese Brown. Theodore M. Medlyn, Esq, and Jerome R. Bowen of the Bowen Law Offices were retained and filed a Notice of Appearance on April 1, 2021. Tyrese Brown on April 8, 2021 filed his own pro se Petition for Guardianship alleging that he held Financial and Medical Power of Attorney. The Legal Aid Center was Appointed as counsel for the Proposed Protected Person Mae R. Brown in both cases, on April 6, 2021 and April 14, 2021 respectively.

Frank, J. Toti, Esq. was retained by Cross-Petitioner Tyrese Brown, and on April 29, 2021, filed a Notice of Appearance and Objection to Petition for Guardianship of Mae R. Brown. Bowen Law Offices Filed a notice fo related Cases on April 30, 2021. On that same day, Scott Cardenas filed his Objection to the Petition for Appointment of Guardian into both Cases, citing NRS 159.044(2)(i) and arguing that a guardianship case *must* be dismissed if it does not contain a physicians certificate with the petition. On May 2, 2021 Petitioner Shawntina Palimore-Brown filed a Reply in Support of Petition citing NRS 159.044 and other alleged authority and arguing that the facts alleged in the instant case allowed the Court to in its discretion permit discovery of items not

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yet included with the petition.

A Hearing for Citation to Show Cause was held on May 6, 2021; Therein the court, after argument, found it was bound by statute to dismiss the matter due to the lack of Physicians Certificate; the Court also ordered the cases be condensed into the lower-numbered action. An Order to that effect was prepared and filed on May 14, 2021. The Bowen Law Offices on behalf of Appellant filed a Notice Of Appeal on May 14, 2021, seeking *de novo* review of the District Court's interpretation and application of NRS 159.044.
