

On May 19, 2021, James W. Hardesty, Chief Justice of the Nevada Supreme Court, filed a petition requesting that the Nevada Supreme Court consider creating a Commission on Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure.

The Nevada Supreme Court will conduct a public hearing on the petition on Monday, June 28, 2021, at 4:00 p.m. in the Nevada Supreme Court Courtroom, 408 East Clark Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada. The hearing will be videoconferenced to the Nevada Supreme Court Courtroom, 201 South Carson Street, Carson City, Nevada.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, while in the courtroom attendees will be required to abide by the court's masking and social distancing standards then in effect, consistent with recommendations by the CDC and this court's protocols. The court will also maintain recommended sanitizing standards from the CDC in the courtroom between each public comment.
