*AMENDED ORDER APPOINTING MEMBER TO THE COMMISSION
TO STUDY BEST PRACTICES FOR VIRTUAL ADVOCACY IN
NEVADA'S COURTS*

On August 13, 2021, this court created the Commission to Study Best Practices for Virtual Advocacy in Nevada's Courts to evaluate applicable rules to govern the unified use of remote technology in Nevada's general and limited jurisdiction courts and consider possible rule changes necessary for handling criminal, civil, and family courts. This court filed an order on January 19, 2023, appointing Justice Patricia Lee as a member of the Commission. That order is hereby amended to appoint Justice Lee to replace Justice James W. Hardesty (ret.) as co-chair of the Commission effective immediately.
