- 1. Defendant is guilty of the crime of Child Abuse with Substantial Bodily Harm, a violation of NRS 200.508(1)(a)(2), a category B felony, as charged in the Information.
 - 2. Sentence is imposed as follows:
- a) Imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections is imposed for a maximum term of one hundred forty-four (144) months with a minimum parole eligibility of sixty (60) months, with credit for time served of one thousand one hundred forty-four (1144) days.
- b) Payment shall be made to the Clerk of the Second Judicial District Court as follows:
 - (1) Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee;

- (2) Three Dollar (\$3.00) administrative assessment to obtain a biological specimen and conduct a genetic marker analysis;
 - (3) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for legal representation.
- c) Restitution shall be paid in the amount of Five Thousand Eight
 Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$5865.90) to victim Department of Family
 Services, through the Division of Parole and Probation.
- 3. Pursuant to Article 1, Section 8 of the Nevada Constitution, all monetary payments, money and property collected from the Defendant shall be first applied to pay the amount ordered as restitution to victim Department of Family Services, Nev. Const. art. 1, §8.
- 4. Any restitution, fine, fee, and administrative assessment imposed by this Judgment of Conviction constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised Statutes NRS 176.275. Should the Defendant fail to pay any restitution, fine, fee or assessment imposed, collection efforts may be undertaken against him.

Counsel acknowledged receipt of the Notice that the hearing was taking place pursuant to Nevada Supreme Court Rules – Part 9 relating to simultaneous audiovisual transmissions and all counsel stated that they had no objection to going forward in this manner.

Counsel Neidert addressed and advised the Court that he has had enough time to speak with his client and they are ready to proceed. **COURT** reviewed the Motion for Bail Reduction filed July 24, 2020 and the Opposition to Motion filed July 31, 2020.

Counsel Neidert addressed the Court and argued in support of the Motion for Bail Reduction pursuant to the Valdez-Jimenez standard. Counsel Neidert reviewed Frye v. District Court.

Counsel Samples addressed and advised the Court that the State does not dispute that NRS 178.498 and NRS 178.4853 apply to this hearing.

Counsel Neidert presented further argument in support of a bail reduction to \$10,000 bondable and/or and own recognizance release and provided a procedural background of the Defendant's prior case and the case at bar. Counsel Neidert further addressed concerns regarding the possible intimidation of witness Shannon Mendoza.

The Defendant was sworn, read aloud 2 letters addressing his participation in classes while in custody at the Washoe County Jail and read a personal statement.

Counsel Samples questioned the Defendant.

Counsel Samples addressed Defendant's concerns regarding the phone call to Ms. Mendoza and indicated that the phone call did not come from the District Attorney's Office but from the H.S.A. office. Counsel Samples provided argument in opposition of a bail reduction and argued that the Defendant is a danger to this community and that there are no conditions that the Court can impose that would protect the community and the victim.

Counsel Neidert requested a short recess to allow him to speak with his client.

Recess taken.

Court reconvened with all parties present.

Counsel Neidert provided further argument in support of reduction Defendant's bail or in the alternative granting the Defendant an O/R release with pretrial services supervision.

COURT considered the Defendant's financial ability to make bail, the Defendant's character, length of residence in the community, his status and history of employment, his relationships with family and friends, his reputation, character and mental condition and his prior criminal record. **COURT** also considered the nature of the offense, and danger to the alleged victim.

COURT FINDS that the State has met its burden, by clear and convincing information, that an O/R release is not appropriate in this case.

COURT ORDERED Bail reduced to \$75,000.00, bondable, with pretrial services supervision if posted. Conditions of pretrial supervision shall include the Defendant seeking and securing employment, providing proof of any income and having no contact with his children without prior Court approval, specifically Chloe and Logan.

Respective counsel acknowledged receipt of notice that the hearing was taking place pursuant to the Second Judicial District Court's Administrative Orders entered in 2020, and the Nevada Supreme Court Rules - Part IX governing appearances by simultaneous audiovisual transmissions, and counsel stated they had no objection to proceeding in this manner. COURT FINDS Braxton Cheyanne Garcia is guilty of the crime of Child Abuse with Substantial Bodily Harm, a violation of NRS 200.508(1)(a)(2), a category B felony, as charged in the Information. **COURT ORDERED** Imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections is imposed for a maximum term of one hundred forty-four (144) months with a minimum parole eligibility of sixty (60) months, with credit for time served of one thousand one hundred forty-four (1144) days.

COURT ORDERED Payment shall be made to the Clerk of the Second Judicial District Court as follows: Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee, Three Dollar (\$3.00) administrative assessment to obtain a biological specimen and conduct a genetic marker analysis and Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for legal representation.

COURT FURTHER ORDERED Restitution shall be paid in the amount of Five Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$5865.90) to victim Department of Family Services, through the Division of Parole and Probation. Pursuant to Article 1, Section 8 of the Nevada Constitution, all monetary payments, money, and property collected from the Defendant shall be first applied to pay the amount ordered as restitution to victim Department of Family Services, Nev. Const. art. 1, §8. Any restitution, fine, fee, and administrative assessment imposed by this Judgment of Conviction constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised Statutes NRS 176.275. Should the Defendant fail to pay any restitution, fine, fee or assessment imposed, collection efforts may be undertaken against him.
