ORDER

Respondent moves to dismiss this appeal on the ground that appellant has failed to timely file the transcript request form or certificate that no transcript will be requested. NRAP 9(a). Appellant opposes the motion and respondent has filed a reply. Appellant concedes that she inadvertently failed to file the transcript request form and informs this court that she intends to file the request. Appellant attempted to file a transcript request form on October 11, 2021, but because the form was due August 23, 2021, the clerk of this court rejected the form as untimely. Appellant has filed a "Motion to Extend Time to File Rough Draft Transcript Form" with the transcript request form attached. Despite respondent's opposition, the motion is granted. The clerk of this court shall detach the rough draft transcript request form from the motion and shall file it separately.

The motion to dismiss the appeal is denied. Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a fast track reply

to respondent's fast track response. *See* NRAP 3E(d)(3). Failure to file a timely fast track reply may be treated as a waiver of the right to file a reply.

It is so ORDERED.
