*ORDER*

Respondents Shafik Hirji, Shafik Brown, and Furniture  
Boutique, LLC's (collectively, the Hirji respondents) motion for leave to file

an answering brief in excess of the type-volume limitation is granted. NRAP 32(a)(7)(A)(ii), (D). The answering brief was filed on October 1, 2021.

Additionally, respondent Steven Barket filed a limited joinder to appellants' opening brief on October 1, 2021. The Hirji respondents have filed a motion to strike the joinder. Appellants have filed a limited opposition to the motion to strike, and take no position as to the arguments for or against Barket's joinder. Barket has filed an opposition to the motion to strike, and the Hirji respondents have filed a reply.

Because Barket is not an appellant in this appeal, he may not join appellants' opening brief. Accordingly, the joinder is disapproved and the motion to strike it is granted. The clerk shall strike the joinder filed on October 1, 2021. Barket and G65 Ventures, LLC shall have 30 days from the date of this order to file and serve an answering brief. NRAP 31(a)(1)(C). If Barket and G65 Ventures do not intend to file an answering brief, they shall inform this court in writing within the same time period.
