It is further ordered that Marchai is awarded costs of \$3,959.06, jointly and severally, against SFR and Cristela Perez. The Court has attempted to apportion the costs between SFR and Perez but finds that apportionment is impracticable. Marchai's principal claim in this action (which it asserted against both SFR and Perez) is for judicial foreclosure. The costs Marchai incurred—except those excluded by the Court—were to further its claim for judicial foreclosure against SFR and Perez and protect its deed of trust from SFR's claim that the association's foreclosure extinguished Marchai's deed of trust.
