ORDER

Appellants' motion requesting a third extension of time to file the opening brief is granted as follows. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). A noncompliant opening brief was filed on February 14, 2022. Appellants filed a corrected opening brief and an appendix on February 15, 2022. The clerk of this court shall strike the noncompliant opening brief filed on February 14, 2022.

This court's review of the appendix filed on February 15, 2022, reveals that it does not conform to the requirements of NRAP 30. It does not contain the documents required by NRAP 30(b)(2), it does not include a cover sheet as required by NRAP 30(c)(3), and the index does not indicate the page or volume numbers for the documents as required by NRAP 30(c)(1). Accordingly, the clerk of this court shall strike the appendix filed on February 15, 2022.

Appellants shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve a corrected appendix that conforms to the requirements of NRAP 30 and 32. Respondent shall have 37 days from the date of this order to file and serve the answering brief.
