APPELLANTS MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR REHEARING

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(A) and NRAP 27, Appellants move for an extension of time to file their Petition for Rehearing in accordance with the facts, points and authorities sited herein.

I. STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE.

Appellants request an extension of time to file the Petition for Rehearing in this Court to July 20, 2022 in accordance with the challenges Appellants had in filing the Petition.

II. FACTS.

Appellants filed their Petition for Rehearing timely and paid the fee of \$150.00 as Ordered on July 19, 2022. However, the eflex website refused to process Appellants rehearing petition fee payment of \$150.00, stating that there was a "handshake_error" or a statement to that effect. Prior to asking for this extension of time, Appellants attempted filing on multiple occasions and could not determine why the payment was not processing. This was preventing the filing from

occurring on time, as the filing is stating "payment pending" for the filing status.

In order to preclude this petition from being late filed,
Appellants are using an abundance of caution in order to ensure that
the Petition is accepted as having been filed in a timely manner.
Appellants are requesting a 1 day extension to July 20, 2022 to ensure
that payment glitch on the eflex website is resolved and the payment
pending status changes to filing complete status or words to that
effect. Appellants will call the Supreme Court Clerk on the first
thing on the morning of July 20, 2022, to ensure the filing issues are
resolved as soon as is possible.

Appellants have made a prior request for an extension to file this Petition. Appellants' Petition was previously due on July 5, 2022 and requested and received one oral 14 day extension from the Supreme Court Clerk. However, through excusable neglect, the Petition failed to file with this Court.

DECLARATION OF ANDREW WASIELEWSKI IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR EXTENSION

ANDREW WASIELEWSKI, declares, pursuant to NRS § 53.045, under penalty of perjury, that the following is true and correct:

- 1. I am over the age of 18 years and have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein, except for those stated upon information and belief, and as to those, I believe them to be true.
- 2. I am the Counsel for the Defendants Margaret Reddy, Mohan
 Thalamarla and Max Global herein. I have been in the practice of law

III. POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

A. APPELLANTS COMPLY WITH THE PROCEDURE TO REQUEST AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE PETITION

NRAP 26(b)(1)(A) states in pertinent part:

"(A) For good cause, the court may extend the time prescribed by these Rules or by its order to perform any act, or may permit an act to be done after that time expires. But the court may not extend the time to file a notice of appeal except as provided in Rule 4(c)."

The Petition was originally due on July 5, 2022. A clerk's extension was previously granted to file this request. The Petition is

due today, July 19, 2022. The one day extension will make the Petition due on July 20, 2022.

No extension has been denied to file this Petition.

An extension is necessary for the following reasons:

- a) Appellants do not understand why the Petition payment did not process and cannot make it process. Appellants pledge to resolve this first thing on July 20, 2022.
- b) Appellants allege that for all these reasons, the requested for extension of time is appropriate and warranted.

The new due date of the Petition would be July 20, 2022. The Petition has been filed already and is in a "payment pending" status for an uncertain reason.

IV. CONCLUSION

Therefore, as Counsel has shown good cause for why this extension is requested and the request is in compliance with NRAP 9 and NRAP 26, Appellants request approval of their request.
