ORDER

Appellant has filed motion and amended motion to vacate this court's order entered October 12, 2021, granting an extension of time for WBG Trust to retain counsel on the ground that WBG Trust was unrepresented at the time.¹ The motion is opposed. It appears the 30-day extension may have been granted in error, but because WBG Trust has now retained counsel of its choosing, this court cannot prevent it from proceeding with counsel. *See United States v. Gonzales-Lopez*, 548 U.S. 140, 144 (2006) (a party has the right to retain counsel of its own choosing). The motion and amended motion to vacate this court's order are denied.
