





ORDER

This court takes no action regarding the document filed on January 4, 2022. The document is titled a motion for an extension to file the opening brief, asks for an extension to file the docketing statement, says the opening brief was filed late, and claims without explanation that good cause exists for an extension to June 26, 2020.

On December 14, 2021, this court issued a notice directing appellant to file the opening brief and appendix within 7 days. This court cautioned that failure to comply could result in the imposition of sanctions. Pursuant to the notice, the opening brief and appendix were due December 21, 2021; to date the documents have not been filed. Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the removal of appellant's counsel as counsel of record and his referral to the state bar for investigation.
