I. **HISTORY OF THE CASE**

Plaintiff and Defendant were married on or before October 2, 2008. The parties have tow minor children to-wit: Abby Reed, born April 6, 2013; and Shawn Reed, born July 3, 2015. Plaintiff filed for his Complaint for Divorce on March 20, 2018 and Defendant filed her Answer and Counterclaim April 10, 2018. Prior to filing the action herein the parties were experiencing numerous issues with their relationship.
