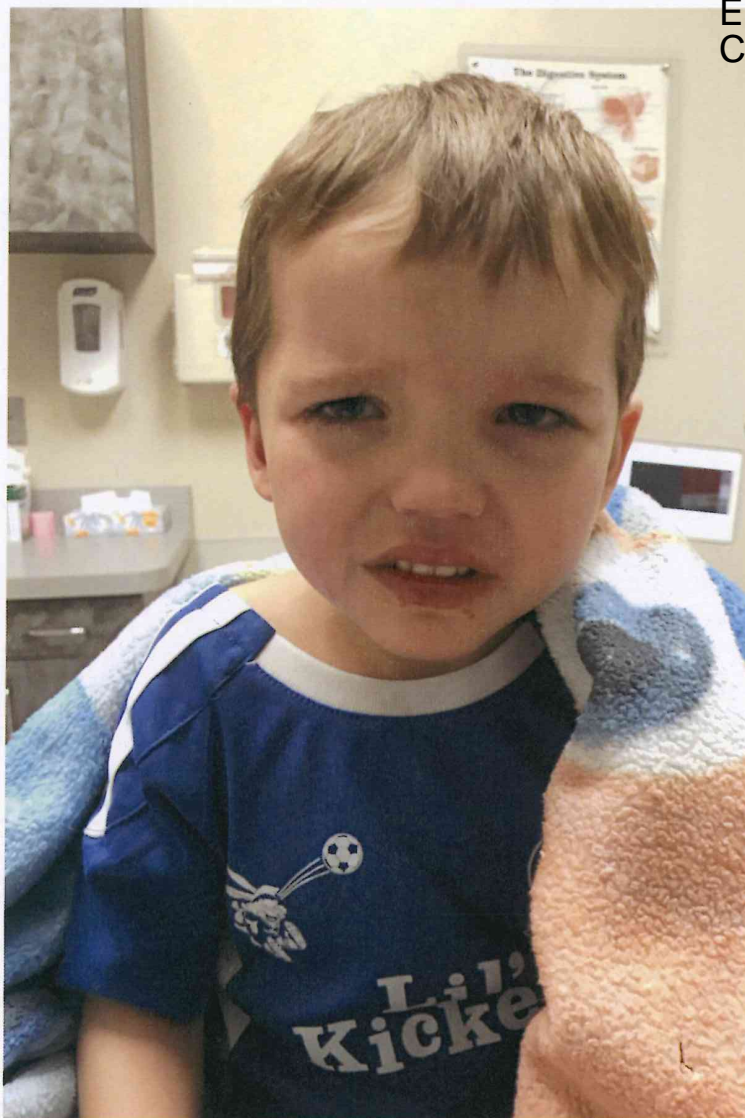



To Whom It May Concern:

I, Theresa Lee Douglass, Principal at Kitty Ward Elementary am writing on behalf of Amanda Reed, mother of Abigail Reed. Abigail attends kindergarten at Kitty Ward Elementary. Her mother, Amanda Reed is a Special education teacher at Kitty Ward Elementary School. Abigail started at Kitty Ward Elementary as a typical peer in our KIDS program since August 2017. Her mother, Amanda Reed, started teaching at Kitty Ward in August, 2018.

Abigail's father, Devin Reed, is contesting that Abigail should not attend Kitty Ward Elementary because he feels that our staff is against him due to the divorce. First of all, I want to address this concern on record. The staff members of Kitty Ward Elementary in no way are indifferent towards any parent in conflict. Most of the staff does not even know Mr. Reed, because he never appears at any school functions. He is the most collegial person we know. The parents, staff members, and community adore him. He has been a blessing in our lives.

Report Narrative

On Tuesday March 20, 2018 at about 2015 hours, Officer Minelli (P1884) and I were dispatched to 4416 Cinderwood in regards to a domestic disturbance.

Upon arrival I met with the person reporting, who identified himself as [REDACTED], and he told me the following: [REDACTED] and his wife filed for divorce today. After having a verbal argument with his wife, identified as [REDACTED], [REDACTED] went outside to his camper that was parked in the driveway. [REDACTED] said he went to the camper to keep the situation from escalating. [REDACTED] noticed that [REDACTED]'s father, identified as Michael Spielberg, was sitting inside his silver Ford pickup across the street. [REDACTED] said that Michael was still seated inside the truck when [REDACTED] heard Michael "cock" a gun. I asked [REDACTED] if he saw the gun, and he said it was a large silver revolver. I asked [REDACTED] if the gun was pointed at him, and he said no, he just heard it being "cocked". [REDACTED] asked Michael if he was going to shoot him, and Michael responded "Maybe". Michael got out of the truck and they met in the middle of the street. [REDACTED] stepped between them to keep them from fighting, and [REDACTED] then called the police. I had [REDACTED] complete a witness statement.

I then spoke to Michael Spielberg. I asked him if he had a gun with him, and he said he did. I asked him where it was, and he said it was inside his truck. I asked him if I could see the gun, and he gave me permission to go inside his truck. I found his black Glock 22 (VSLD57) semi automatic handgun inside the glovebox as described by Michael. There was no other firearms

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inside the cab of the truck. I asked Michael if the gun was produced at anytime during their argument, and he said no. Michael said that [REDACTED] was inside his truck when the confrontation happened. I had Michael complete a witness statement.

I then spoke to [REDACTED], and she told me the following: [REDACTED] said that they had filed for divorce today and were talking about how to settle things. While they were talking, things started to escalate so she called her father, Michael Spielberg, over to talk to [REDACTED] was inside Michael's truck that was parked across the street from the home. While she was talking to Michael, [REDACTED] went inside the home. Fearing that Michael was going to do something, [REDACTED] went inside the home to see what he was doing. Once inside [REDACTED] tried talking to her again, which she refused. [REDACTED] then started yelling at her, claiming that Michael just "cocked" his gun at him. [REDACTED] ran outside to Michael's truck window yelling at Michael in a threatening manner. [REDACTED] stepped between the two men, and [REDACTED] said that he was going to call the police and say that Michael threatened him with the gun.


Since there was claims of a firearm being produced during this incident, I told all parties I would be taking this report for information purposes. [REDACTED] account of handgun being produced did not make sense, nor could he describe the gun.

I conducted a records check of Michael's information, which revealed he had a concealed firearms permit. Michael had one prior citation for battery in 1987.

I spoke to both of them in length about one of them leaving the home while the divorce was in process to minimize future problems. [REDACTED] was not receptive, and stated he was staying in his home regardless. [REDACTED] admitted that she was just afraid of [REDACTED] hurting her pets. I spent several minutes explaining to her that the safety of their children and her were more important. [REDACTED] agreed to go stay at her father's house.
