

*ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS, DIRECTING TRANSMISSION  
OF RECORDS, AND REGARDING BRIEFING*

These pro se appeals are from a single district court order denying a petition for writ of habeas corpus. In the interest of judicial economy, these appeals are consolidated. *See* NRAP 3(b).

This court has concluded that its review of the complete records is warranted (district court case nos. A- 21-834858-W and A-21-835317-W). *See* NRAP 10(a)(1). Accordingly, the clerk of the district court shall have 30 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court certified copies of the complete trial court records of these appeals. *See* NRAP 11(a)(2). The records shall include copies of documentary exhibits submitted in the district court proceedings, but shall not include any physical, non-documentary exhibits or the original documentary exhibits. The records shall also include any presentence investigation reports

submitted in a sealed envelope identifying the contents and marked confidential. See NRS 176.156(5).

Within 120 days, appellant may file either (1) a single brief that complies with the requirements in NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32; or (2) a single "Informal Brief Form for Pro Se Parties" provided by the supreme court clerk. NRAP 31(a)(1). If no brief is submitted, these appeals may be decided on the records on appeal. NRAP 34(g). Respondent need not file a response to any brief filed by appellant, unless ordered to do by this court. NRAP 46A(c). The court generally will not grant relief without providing an opportunity to file a response. *Id.*

It is so ORDERED.
