

COUNT THREE: Lewdness with a Child Under 16 Years of Age, a violation of NRS 201.230(1)(a) and (3), a category B felony, imprisonment in the state prison for a maximum term of one hundred twenty (120) months and a minimum term of forty-eight (48) months to run consecutive to the sentences imposed in count one and count two.

COUNT FOUR: Lewdness with a Child Under 16 Years of Age, a violation of NRS 201.230(1)(a) and (3), a category B felony, imprisonment in the state prison for a maximum term of one hundred twenty (120) months and a minimum term of forty-eight (48) months to run consecutive to the sentences imposed in count one, count two and count three.
