

ORDER DENYING MOTION

This is an appeal from a postjudgment order in a divorce matter. Appellant has filed a motion to stay the briefing so that he can file a motion in the district court pursuant to NRCP 60(b). Appellant has not provided this court with an indication that the district court is inclined to grant the relief sought or that appellant has followed the procedure for seeking a limited remand outlined in NRAP 12A. *See also Huneycutt v. Huneycutt*, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.2d 585 (1978), and *Foster v. Dingwall*, 126 Nev. 49, 52-53, 228 P.3d 453, 455-56 (2010) (clarifying the remand procedure set forth in *Huneycutt*). Accordingly, the motion is denied. Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief.

It is so ORDERED.
