ORDER

Appellant Mary-Anne Colt's motion for an extension of time to file the fast track statement and for leave to file a fast track statement in excess of 10 pages is granted. NRAP 3E(f)(3), NRAP 3E(e)(2). The clerk of this court shall detach the documents attached to the fast track statement received on June 14, 2021, and return them unfiled, and shall file the fast track statement. See NRAP 3E(d)(5) (a pro se appellant shall not file an appendix).

Appellant Stacey Kanter's fast track statement was due to be filed no later than June 7, 2021. NRAP 3E(d)(1). To date, no fast track statement has been filed. Ms. Kanter shall file and serve the fast track statement within 7 days from the date of this order. Failure to comply with this order may result in the dismissal of Ms. Kanter's appeal.

Respondent shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve the fast track response. NRAP 3E(d)(2).
