*ORDER*

Appellant has filed a pro se motion making several requests for relief. First, appellant questions whether Patricia Foley should be a respondent to this matter and asks whether she should be notified of appellants' filings. Review of the notice of appeal and documents before this court indicates that Patricia Foley was the petitioner in the underlying case and the Clark County District Attorney was not a party to the underlying case. Accordingly, it appears the respondent was misidentified when this appeal was docketed. The clerk shall modify the caption of this appeal to remove the Clark County District Attorney as the respondent and add Patricia Foley in its place.

Appellant next requests an extension of time to file the docketing statement. The untimely motion is granted. NRAP 26(b)(1)(A). The clerk shall file the docketing statement received on May 10, 2021.

Finally, appellant expresses concern about missing or delayed communications from this court and the other parties due to delays in the mail service. He asks that he be notified via email whenever there is a filing in this matter. Appellant may request that respondent serve him electronically with any filings but respondent is not required to do so. See NRAP 25(c). This court will not provide appellant with an email notification

each time a document is filed in this matter. However, appellant may electronically check the docket of this appeal for new filings through the public portal of this court's Appellate Case Management System as often as he desires.
