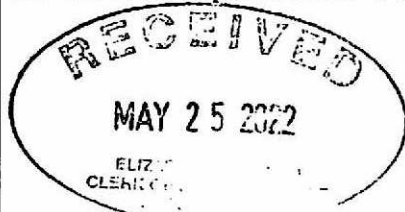

PETITION FOR REVIEW

Petitioner, Natasha Early comes in Proper Person and hereby request the court to grant a Petition for Review of the Appellate Courts affirmance entered on April 21, 2022 because the issues involved is one of Statewide Public Importance. In essence the Appellate Court failed to grasps the core issue of Petitioner's case, being that the Governor declared a mandate that all unemployment claims during the Covid 19 pandemic were to be backdated to March 15, 2020. That being the

1 case Petitioner should have had her 2019 claim re opened as it was still not yet
2 expired. No appeal process exists to reopen a claim once it has expired. Because
3 Petitioner could not get her claim in until August of 2020 the respondents placed
4 her involuntarily into a new claim that was not adequate. Therefore the writ of
5 mandamus must issue to reopen the 2019 claim as a backdated claim which will
6 entitle her to \$285 per week on an Emergency Unemployment Claim extension for
7 26 weeks. The Appellate Court mooted her motions for expedited review and she
8 did not get a fair hearing.
