case Petitioner should have had her 2019 claim re opened as it was still not yet expired. No appeal process exists to reopen a claim once it has expired. Because Petitioner could not get her claim in until August of 2020 the respondents placed her involuntarily into a new claim that was not adequate. Therefore the writ of mandamus must issue to reopen the 2019 claim as a backdated claim which will entitle her to \$285 per week on an Emergency Unemployment Claim extension for 26 weeks. The Appellate Court mooted her motions for expedited review and she did not get a fair hearing.
