**MOTION FOR 24-HOUR EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO
FILE MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMICUS BRIEF AND BRIEF OF *AMICI CURIAE* IN
SUPPORT OF PETITIONER
[SECOND REQUEST]**

Proposed Amici Curiae Nevada Hospital Association, Sunrise Hospital, Mountain View Hospital, Southern Hills Hospital, Valley Health System, LLC, Renown Regional Medical Center, Renown South Meadows Medical Center, and Dignity Health D/B/A St. Rose Dominican – Rose De Lima, St. and Rose Dominican – Siena, St. Rose Dominican – San Martin, submit their motion for a 24-hour extension of the 30-day deadline imposed by this Court in its Order dated December 3, 2021, for the filing of the Proposed Amici's Motion for Leave to File an Amicus Brief, and to file the Amicus Brief, from January 3, 2022, to January 4, 2022. This is the second request for leave to file beyond the statutory

deadline for a proposed amicus brief.

This request is not made to delay the proceedings. Proposed Amici make this request due to computer issues apparently caused by a recent MacBook software update that have impeded the ability of the principal drafter of the Amicus brief to connect to firm resources via Citrix technology, and have prevented the final preparation and filing of the Motion and Proposed Amicus Brief. This difficulty has been exacerbated by the fact that the law firm of Greenberg Traurig is observing the New Year Holiday on January 3, 2022, limiting the availability of firm staff to assist the principal drafter in remedying the problems caused by the MacBook update. However, the principal drafter is confident that the issues can be resolved within 24 hours, and therefore request this short extension.
