ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion for leave to file a document under seal. However, appellant has not provided this court with a copy of the document he wishes to file under seal. *See Howard v. State*, 128 Nev. 736, 746, 291 P.3d 137, 143 (2012) ("The records or documents that are the subject of the motion [to seal] may be submitted separately and will remain confidential for a reasonable period of time pending this court's resolution of the motion."); *cf.* SRCR 3(2). Accordingly, this court defers ruling on the motion. Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to provide this court with a copy of the document he seeks to file under seal. Failure to timely comply will result in the denial of the motion.
