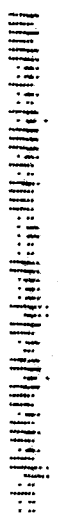

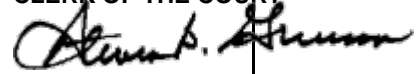



1 THE COURT FINDS that Petitioner Corey Johnson (“Mr. Johnson”) is currently incarcerated at  
2 High Desert State Prison and is serving time for criminal acts he committed on or about May 19, 2009  
3 (*Case No. 10C263976*); on or about September 25, 2009 (*Case No. 09C260737*); and on or between  
4 February 1, 2010, and February 24, 2010 (*Case No. 10C264344*). The Eighth Judicial District Court  
5 adjudicated Mr. Johnson guilty of Burglary (*Case No. 10C263976*), Attempt Theft (*Case No.*  
6 *09C260737*), and Possession or Sale of Document or Personal Identifying Information (*Case No.*  
7 *10C264344*), all category B felonies.

8 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Mr. Johnson was sentenced to three concurrent terms of

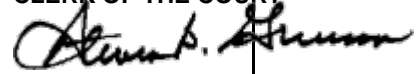



3 that either were or could have been presented in an earlier proceeding unless the court finds both cause  
4 for failing to present the claims earlier or for raising them again and actual prejudice to the petitioner).  
5 Since Mr. Johnson failed to challenge his current claims in his original petition, and did not demonstrate  
6 good cause and prejudice, he cannot use his current ten pleadings as a vehicle to challenge new and  
7 different grounds for relief. Due to Mr. Johnson's successive filings, he committed an abuse of writ and  
8 his five motions and five petitions are dismissed.

9 WHEREFORE THE COURT FURTHER CONCLUDES that Mr. Johnson continues to file  
10 frivolous pleadings challenging the constitutionality of his preliminary inquiry and parole revocation  
11 hearing along with challenging the calculation of his prison credits due to his parole violation. Mr.  
12 Johnson raised these same claims in the state district court in Case Nos. 10C263976, 10C264344, A-21-  
13 828907-W, A-21-828910-W, A-21-829138-W, A-21-830033-W, A-20-824136-W, A-20-822586-W, A-20-  
14 824942-W, A-20-821716-W, A-21-836421-W, A-21-836422-W, and A-21-836423-W. In total, Mr.  
15 Johnson alleged the same claims in 13 state district court cases, 12 Nevada Supreme Court cases<sup>1</sup>, and 1  
16 federal district court case<sup>2</sup>. Although this Court continuously denied Mr. Johnson's request for relief, as  
17 to these same issues, Mr. Johnson continues to file multiple pleadings in this Court raising the exact same  
18 claims. Mr. Johnson is well-aware that his five motions and five petitions are not supported under existing  
19 law, and contains allegations for which evidentiary support is not available. *NRS 209.451(1)(d)(2) and*  
20 *(3)*. Mr. Johnson not only burdened multiple courts with his frivolous filings, but he filed multiple  
21 pleadings for the sole purpose of harassing Respondents, caused unnecessary delay in the litigation, and  
22 increased the cost of the litigation by wasting judicial resources. *NRS 209.451(1)(d)(1)*. Since Mr.  
23 Johnson's claims in his ten pleadings are not supported by governing law and/or lack evidentiary support  
24 and/or harassing, his pleadings are denied. Additionally, this Court will set this matter for a status check  
25 for possible referral to the Nevada Department of Corrections for appropriate sanctions. *See NRS*
