## SETTLEMENT PROGRAM INTERIM STATUS REPORT

The undersigned Settlement Judge submits this interim status report, as follows.

/X / Other: A resumed Pre-Mediation Conference in this matter has been rescheduled numerous times thus far --- including today's vacation of the most-recently-set date of March 14, 2022. The reason given by counsel for each rescheduling is the same. Specifically, according to both sides' counsel, (A) the District Court still has not rendered a ruling or issued an order resolving either of the fully-briefed and argued applications to tax costs and for attorneys' fees, and (B) the District Court's resolution of those applications will materially affect potential settlement, no matter how resolved by the District Court.

Counsel for the parties to this appeal agreed, today, to re-set the resumed Pre-Mediation Conference for April 14, 2022, commencing at 8:30 a.m.

The undersigned believes that --- without an extension --- a final status report is due to be filed in this matter by April 11, 2022.

For the foregoing reasons, the undersigned requests and recommends that the Court extend the time for the filing of a final report in this matter for an additional 90-days, beyond the current April 11, 2022 filing deadline.
