

ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS

These appeals arise from the same district court case and involve the same parties and largely the same counsel. Accordingly, this court hereby consolidates these appeals. NRAP 3(b)(2). Briefing shall proceed as follows.

PAMPT, LLC shall have until December 20, 2022, to file and serve a combined opening brief in Docket No. 83598 and opening brief in Docket No. 85358. Kenneth F. Potashner; VTB Holdings, Inc.; Stripes Group, LLC; SG VTB Holdings, LLC; Juergen Stark; and Kenneth Fox (hereinafter collectively Potashner) shall have 30 days from service of PAMPT's combined brief to file and serve a combined answering brief in Docket No. 85398, answering brief in Docket No. 85358, and opening brief in Docket No. 84971. PAMPT shall have 30 days from service of Potashner's combined brief to file and serve a combined reply brief in Docket No. 85398, reply brief in Docket No. 85358, and answering brief in Docket No. 84971. Potashner shall have 30 days from service of PAMPT's second combined brief to file and serve a reply brief in Docket No. 84971. Failure to timely file and serve briefs in this matter may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
