

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Extraordinary and compelling circumstances having been shown, appellant's motion requesting a second extension of time to file the opening brief is granted. NRAP 26(b)(1)(B). Appellant shall have until March 1, 2022, to file and serve the opening brief. No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary and compelling circumstances. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
