*ORDER REINSTATING BRIEFING*

On November 4, 2021, this court suspended the briefing of this appeal because the notice of appeal was filed after the district court orally pronounced its decision but before entry of a written order. Appellant shall have 120 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed as provided in NRAP 31(a)(1).
