15 **JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION**

16 Defendant, JOSHUA ALEXANDER DURAN ("Defendant) entered a plea of Guilty to
17 the charge in this matter. No legal reason or cause precludes entry of judgment against
18 him. Therefore, the Court renders judgment as follows:

19 1. Defendant is guilty of the crime of Burglary of a Business, a violation of NRS
20 205.060, a category C felony, as charged in the Information.

21 2. Sentence is imposed as follows:

22 a) Imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections is imposed for
23 a maximum term of thirty-six (36) months with a minimum parole eligibility of twelve (12)
24 months, to run consecutive to the sentence imposed in Case No. CR21-1433, with credit
25 for time served of zero (0) days.

26 b) Payment shall be made to the Clerk of the Second Judicial District
27 Court as follows:

28 (1) Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee;

1 (2) Three Dollar (\$3.00) administrative assessment to obtain a
2 biological specimen and conduct a genetic marker analysis; and

3 (3) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for legal representation.

4 3. Any restitution, fine, fee, and administrative assessment imposed by
5 this Judgment of Conviction constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised Statutes NRS
6 176.275. Should the Defendant fail to pay any restitution, fine, fee or assessment
7 imposed, collection efforts may be undertaken against him.

Sentencing

This hearing was held remotely, the Court and all participants appeared via simultaneous audiovisual transmission. The Court was physically located in Washoe County, Nevada which was the site of the court session. At the direction of the Court, all participants stated their appearances and location. Respective counsel acknowledged receipt of notice that the hearing was taking place pursuant to the Second Judicial District Court's Administrative Orders entered in 2020 and 2021, and the Nevada Supreme Court Rules - Part IX governing appearances by simultaneous audiovisual transmissions, and counsel stated they had no objection to proceeding in this manner. The Court further made a record that these proceedings are open to the public for viewing and listening through the webinar/meeting invitation located on the Court's website and directed that if at any time anyone who is participating in this matter cannot see or hear the other participants in this case, they are to inform the Court.

Counsel Garcia addressed and advised the Court that she has had ample time to speak with her client and they are ready to proceed.
COURT FINDS this action is impacted by Article 1, Section 8A(1)(q) of the Nevada Constitution; Marsy's Law.

Counsel Heidrich addressed and advised the Court that the victim has been notified.

TRUE NAME: JOSHUA ALEXANDER DURAN, as stated on line 12 of the Information. Defendant was in receipt of the Information, waived reading. Counsel Garcia stated the plea negotiations as outlined in the Guilty Plea Memorandum (GPM) to include the parties are free to argue for an appropriate sentence, including concurrent or consecutive time with any other case; Counsel Heidrich concurred with the stated plea negotiations.

Defendant was sworn.

COURT canvassed the Defendant, advised him of his rights, found that there was a factual basis for the plea.

Counsel Heidrich recited the elements of the offense.

Defendant entered a plea of guilty to the crime of Burglary of a Business, a violation of NRS 205.060, a category C felony, as stated in the Information and provided the Court with visual verification of the signed GPM.

COURT further found that the Defendant understood the elements of the offense, the possible punishments, that the plea was knowing, voluntary and intelligent, and that the Defendant was competent to enter the plea. **COURT** accepted the plea.

COURT ORDERED the preparation of a presentence investigation report (PSI).

Counsel Garcia moved for a bail hearing and/or an O/R release to an in-patient treatment program.

Counsel Heidrich stated his objections to hearing a bail hearing at this time and/or the Motion for O/R Release to an in-patient treatment program.

Counsel Garcia further advised the Court that the Defendant has completed the application for New Frontier and is waiting on his evaluation.

COURT directed Counsel Garcia to file a Motion for Bail Reduction and/or a Motion for O/R Release to Treatment.

COURT ORDERED: Matter continued for entry of judgment and imposition of sentence to October 7, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.

Defendant remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
