*ORDER CORRECTING AMENDMENTS TO
NEVADA CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT RULES 4.2(C) AND (C)(3)*

On December 1, 2021, this court entered an order amending Nevada Code of Judicial Conduct (NCJC) 4.2(C) and (C)(3) and NCJC 4.2(A)(6) and deleting NCJC 4.2(D). We have determined that amendment of Exhibit A to the order is warranted to correct clerical errors. Accordingly, the clerk of this court is directed to modify Exhibit A to the order filed on December 1, 2021, by replacing "March 17, 2022" in NCJC 4.2(C) with "March 18, 2022." The amended rule will now read:

A judge or judicial candidate who is not opposed in an election must not solicit or accept contributions for the candidate's campaign, either personally or through a candidate's committee, from and after 5 p.m. on March 18, 2022.

Exhibit A is further modified by replacing "January 15, 2022" in NCJC 4.2(C)(3) with "January 14, 2022." The amended rule will now read:

A judge or candidate for judicial office who has announced their intention to file for a judicial office and/or the judge or candidate's committees may solicit or accept contributions for the judge or candidate's campaign no earlier than 5:00 p.m. on January 14, 2022, and, unless unopposed, no later

than 90 days after the last election in which the candidate participates during the election year.

It is so ORDERED.¹
