**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER TO
PETITION FOR REHEARING OF REAL PARTIES IN INTEREST
SANDRA AND ANTHONY CAMACHO
(First Request)**

Real Parties in Interest, Sandra and Anthony Camacho (collectively “Plaintiffs”), respectfully move this Court, pursuant to NRAP 26(b) for an extension of 30 days in which to file their answer to petition for rehearing.

Plaintiffs’ answer to petition for rehearing is currently due on September 7, 2022. This is Plaintiffs’ first motion for extension of time. No request for additional time has been denied or denied in part. If the Court grants this request for an extension of 30 days, Plaintiffs’ answer to petition for rehearing will be due Friday, October 7, 2022.

Good cause exists to grant the requested extension for the following reasons:

1. Plaintiffs’ appellate counsel, Micah Echols, has been heavily involved in both pretrial motion practice and related trial preparation in Clark County Nevada, District Court in *Farris v. Rives, M.D.*, A-16-739464-C, in which several motions have been filed over the last several weeks on shortened time. The jury trial is scheduled to begin September 6, 2022, with jury selection.

2. Mr. Echols has worked diligently to meet the current filing deadline on the answer to petition for rehearing. The additional time is needed to finalize the answer and allow sufficient time for co-counsel to review.

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This motion is submitted in good faith and for good cause shown in accordance with NRAP 26(b). For the foregoing reasons, Plaintiffs respectfully request a 30-day extension of time, until October 7, 2022, within which to file their answer to petition for rehearing.
