DECLARATION OF W. JEREMY STORMS

- 1. I am an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and a Chief Deputy for the Special Public Defender assigned to represent Mr. Lepolo on his writ of mandamus before this Court.
- 2. The Clark County Special Public Defender was appointed to represent Mr. Lepolo on October 29, 2019.
- 3. On November 10, 2021, a Petition for Writ of Mandamus was filed in the Nevada Supreme Court. While a decision was pending as to the Petition, there was a breakdown in the attorney/client relationship.

- 4. At a hearing on a motion to dismiss for a speedy trial violation on December 3, 2021, before the District Court in Case No. C-20-345911-1, the Court conducted *Young* hearing without the presence of the District Attorney. The Court ordered the Special Public Defender's Office was dismissed and set a hearing to appoint new counsel. See Minutes December 3, 2021 attached.
- 5. On December 10, 2021, the Court appointed Jason Margolis, Esq. as attorney for Mr. Lepolo in Case Number C-20-245911-1.
- 6. On December 23, 2021, this Court filed an Order that the Real Party in Interest's Answer to the Writ of Mandamus was due within 28 days of the Order and that the Petitioner would have 14 days thereafter to file a reply.
- 7. As the Special Public Defender was dismissed as counsel in the district court case which is the underlying case for the Writ of Mandamus, Counsel requests that this Court allow the Special Public Defender to withdraw as counsel in the instant matter. It is further requested that this Court allow Mr. Margolis to file the appropriate Notice of Appearance and take over representation in this case.
