POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

NRAP 41(b)(3)(A) provides for a stay of the issuance of this Court's remittitur pending filing of a petition for certiorari in the United States Supreme Court. The rule contemplates a stay of 120 days unless good cause is shown. Once the petition is filed, "the stay shall continue until final disposition by the Supreme Court of the United States." NRAP 41(b)(3)(B).

This is a death penalty case. Appellant has raised federal constitutional issues that are subject to review by the United States Supreme Court. Counsel for Mr. Johnson will seek review by filing a petition for certiorari consistent with the U.S. Supreme Court rules.

Accordingly, this Court should stay issuance of remittitur pending the filing and final disposition of Johnson's petition for writ of certiorari.
