



ORDER RECALLING REMITTITUR

On February 22, 2024, this court granted a motion to extend the stay of the remittitur in this appeal. Pursuant to that order, if this court received written notice by March 8, 2024, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant had filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay was to continue in effect until final disposition of United States Supreme Court certiorari proceedings. Although this court received notice on March 6, 2024, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant had filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, on April 16, 2024, this court inadvertently issued the remittitur in this appeal. Accordingly, the clerk of this court shall recall the remittitur. Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed until final disposition of the United States Supreme Court certiorari proceedings.
