



**JUDGMENT ON
ARBITRATION AWARD**

This action came on for arbitration hearing on July 6, 2021, before Arbitrator Martina Shindelus, Esq. presiding, and the issues having been duly heard, a decision having been rendered and the prevailing party having been notified that judgment may be entered in accordance with the award. A Request for Trial de Novo was filed, and thereafter stricken by the court.

The court hereby enters judgment on the Arbitration Award as follows:

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff, AMY AINSWORTH, recover from the Defendant, PILAR ENRIQUE ARBALLO-OLIVAS, the sum of \$35,421.00, plus Pre-Judgment Interest in the amount of \$1,966.59, plus costs in the amount of \$1,407.89, plus attorneys fees in the amount of \$3,000.00 for a total Judgment in the amount of **\$41,795.48**.
