ORDER

On August 26, 2020, Plaintiff, Ricky Nolan, (Nolan) filed a Civil Rights Complaint naming Judge Stefany Miley and Senior Deputy Attorney General (SDAG) Katlyn Brady (collectively, the "Defendants") as Defendants. On April 15, 2021, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss with prejudice. Plaintiff filed an opposition on April 29, 2021. Defendants replied on May 6, 2021. In respect to Judge Stefany Miley and SDAG Katlyn Brady, this Court now *grants* Defendants' motion to dismiss with prejudice.¹

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¹ This Court takes judicial notice of the orders and motions filed in Nolan's criminal matter. *See Breliant v. Preferred Equities Corp.*, 109 Nev. 842, 847, 858 P.2d 1258, 1261 (1993) (holding a court may consider matters of public record in ruling on a motion to dismiss).

CONCLUSIONS OF FACT

The current Complaint focuses on Nolan's criminal case, specifically Defendant Judge Stefany Miley's judicial act of issuing an order.

On March 28, 2018, Nolan filed two separate "Postconviction Petitions Requesting a Genetic Marker Analysis of Evidence within the Possession or Custody of the State of Nevada." While these petitions were pending, Nolan filed a Motion to Modify and/or Correct an Illegal Sentence. On May 11, 2018, the Defendant Miley entered a written order denying the Petitions Requesting a Genetic Marker Analysis.

Nolan's appeal of his Motion to Modify his sentence was assigned appeal number 76572. On October 3, 2018, Nolan submitted a letter to the Nevada Supreme Court asking whether his appeal included both the denial of his post-conviction petitions requesting genetic marker analysis and the denial of his motion for a sentence modification. Nolan argued the petitions and motions were denied by the District Court and further stated he wished to address the petitions in his opening brief. The Nevada Supreme Court entered an order stating the appeal addressed both the denial of his petitions requesting genetic marker analysis and the denial of his motion for modification of his sentence.

Pursuant to NRAP 17(b), the Nevada Supreme Court transferred Nolan's appeal to the Nevada Court of Appeals. On August 27, 2019, the Nevada Court of Appeals entered an order affirming the District Court's order denying the Petitions for Genetic Marker Analysis. Subsequently, Nolan filed a civil complaint, assigned case no. A-20-813173-C (the Court of Appeals Complaint). The Court of Appeals Complaint named the Honorable Chief Judge Michael Gibbons, Judge Bonnie Bulla, and Judge Jerome Tao (the "Judicial Defendants") as defendants.

Relevant to this matter, the Court of Appeals Complaint alleged the Judicial Defendants did not have jurisdiction to consider Nolan's appeal of Judge Miley's previous order denying Nolan's petitions for genetic marker analysis. Specifically, Nolan argued Judge Miley did not enter a written order denying the petitions and thus the Court of Appeals exceeded its jurisdiction by ruling on the appeal.

Pursuant to NRS 41.0339, the Judicial Defendants received legal representation from the Nevada Attorney General's Office (OAG). Senior Deputy Attorney General, Katlyn M. Brady was assigned to defend that matter.

On July 20, 2020, the Judicial Officers, through Defendant Brady, filed a motion to dismiss the Court of Appeals Complaint with prejudice. Attached to the motion to dismiss was a copy of the May 11, 2018, order denying Nolan's petition for genetic marker testing. The Honorable Judge Crockett dismissed the Court of Appeals Complaint with prejudice after finding the Judicial Defendants were entitled to absolute judicial immunity.

In this matter, Nolan argues that Defendant Judge Stefany Miley's May 11, 2018 Order, attached to the Judicial Defendants' motion to dismiss, which was filed by Defendant SDAG Brady, was fabricated by Defendants Judge Stefany Miley and SDAG Brady.²

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A pleading is subject to certain rules; primary among them is that a plaintiff's complaint must adhere to Nev. R. Civ. P. 8(a), which provides:

A pleading which sets forth a claim for relief [. . .] shall contain (1) a short and plain statement of the claim showing that the pleader is entitled to relief; and (2) a demand for judgment for the relief the pleader seeks. Relief in the alternative or of several different types may be demanded.

The State of Nevada follows a notice pleading standard as to Nev. R. Civ. P. 8(a) and the sufficiency of the complaint. See Crucil v. Carson City, 95 Nev. 583, 585, 600 P.2d 216, 217 (1979) ("[T]he pleading of [a] conclusion, either of law or fact, is sufficient so long as the pleading gives fair notice of the nature and basis of the claim."). Nevertheless, even under the notice pleading standard, "[a] complaint must set forth sufficient facts to establish all necessary elements of a claim for relief [. . .] so that the adverse party has adequate notice of

² This Court notes that the Complaint also named several other defendants. At the June 9, 2021 hearing, Deputy District Attorney Joel Browning specially appeared. Browning noted that his office was notified the morning of June 9, 2021, of Nolan's Complaint. Browning also noted that according to the information then known to him, the Complaint had not been properly served on any defendants. Browning stated that he was not able to accept service on behalf of any defendant at this time. This Court scheduled a status check for July 14, 2021, as to the status of the remaining defendants.

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the nature of the claim and relief sought." Hay v. Hay, 100 Nev. 196, 198, 678 P.2d 672, 674 (1984) (internal citations omitted).

Nev. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(5) allows this Court to dismiss a complaint for "failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted." When reviewing a motion to dismiss under Nev. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(5), this Court "must construe the pleadings liberally and accept all factual allegations in the complaint as true." Blackjack Bonding v. City of Las Vegas Mun. Court, 116 Nev. 1213, 1217, 14 P.3d 1275, 1278 (2000). In doing so, "this [C]ourt must draw every fair inference in favor of the non-moving party." Id. "A complaint will not be dismissed for failure to state a claim unless it appears beyond a doubt that the plaintiff could prove no set of facts which, if accepted by the trier of fact, would entitle him or her to relief." Id. (quoting Simpson v. Mars Inc., 113 Nev. 188, 190, 929 P.2d 966, 967 (1997)).

"As a general rule, the court may not consider matters outside the pleading being attacked." Breliant v. Preferred Equities Corp., 109 Nev. 842, 847, 858 P.2d 1258, 1261 (1993). "However, the court may take into account matters of public record, orders, items present in the record of the case, and any exhibits attached to the complaint when ruling on a motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted." Id. Additionally, "a document is not outside the complaint if the complaint specifically refers to the document and if its authenticity is not questioned." Branch v. Tunnell, 14 F.3d 449, 454 (9th Cir.1994) overruled on other grounds by Galbraith v. Cnty. of Santa Clara, 307 F.3d 1119, 1125–26 (9th Cir.2002).

Dismissing a complaint with prejudice is appropriate when it is clear that allowing a plaintiff an opportunity to amend would be futile. See Lucas v. Dep't of Corr., 66 F.3d 245, 248-49 (9th Cir. 1995) (per curiam) (holding a district court does not abuse its discretion by dismissing a pro se complaint if it is clear that the deficiencies cannot be cured by amendment); see also Cook, Perkiss & Liehe, Inc. v. N. Cal. Collection Serv., Inc., 911 F.2d 242, 247 (9th Cir. 1990).

Judicial immunity is immunity from suit, not just from ultimate assessment of damages." Mireless v. Waco, 502 U.S. 9, 11 (1991). "Absolute immunity is a broad grant of 1 | in
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Nevada law has long recognized the common law rule that communications uttered or published in the course of judicial proceedings are absolutely privileged, rendering those who made the communications immune from civil liability. *Greenberg Traurig v. Frias Holding Co.*, 130 Nev. 627, 630, 331 P.3d 901, 903 (2014) citing *Fink v. Oshins*, 118 Nev. 428, 432–33, 49 P.3d 640, 643 (2002) (quotations omitted). "The policy behind the [litigation] privilege, as it applies to attorneys participating in judicial proceedings, is to grant them 'as officers of the court the utmost freedom in their efforts to obtain justice for their clients." *Id.* at 433, 49 P.3d at 643 (quoting *Bull v. McCuskey*, 96 Nev. 706, 712, 615 P.2d 957, 961 (1980) abrogated on other grounds by Ace Truck & Equip. Rentals, Inc. v. Kahn, 103 Nev. 503, 746 P.2d 132 (1987), abrogated by Bongiovo v. Sullivan, 122 Nev. 556, 138 P.3d 433 (2006)).

The privilege applies so long as the statements are "in some way pertinent to the subject of the controversy." *Id.* at 433, 49 P.3d at 644 (internal quotation omitted). The privilege is almost absolute, in that it applies even if the communications were made with knowledge and malice, *id.* at 433, 49 P.3d at 643. *But see Bull*, 96 Nev. at 712, 615 P.2d at 962 (stating that litigation privilege does not shield an attorney from bar discipline stemming from the attorney's misconduct); *but see also Greenberg Traurig*, 130 Nev. At 631, 331 P.3d at 904 (noting that Nevada recognizes a legal-malpractice exception).

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1	This Court finds that Judge Stefany Miley is entitled to absolute immunity. As
2	alleged, Judge Stefany Miley acted within the course and scope of her judicial duties by
3	entering her May 11, 2018 Order. Under no set of facts, would the allegations and claims
4	in the Complaint prevail over the absolute immunity Judge Stefany Miley is entitled to
5	receive. Therefore, dismissal with prejudice is appropriate, as amendment would be futile.
6	This Court further finds that Defendant SDAG Brady is entitled to immunity under
