ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL IN PART

This is an appeal from a district court order awarding attorney fees. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Nancy L. Allf, Judge.

Initial review of the docketing statement and documents before this court revealed a potential jurisdictional defect. It appeared that appellant Chef Exec Suppliers is not aggrieved by the challenged order because the order awards fees only against appellant Clement Muney. See NRAP 3A(a); Valley Bank of Nevada v. Ginsburg, 110 Nev. 440, 446, 874 P.2d 729, 734 (1994). Therefore, this court ordered Chef Exec Suppliers to show cause why its appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

In response, Chef Exec Suppliers agrees that it is not an appropriate appellant and consents to the dismissal of Chef Exec Suppliers as an appellant. Accordingly, the appeal of Chef Exec Suppliers is dismissed. This appeal shall proceed with Clement Muney as the only appellant.
