JOURNAL ENTRIES

- Phillip Smith, Esq., Attorney for Nevada Properties 1, LLC, dba The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas, Garnishee

Argument by Mr. Smith regarding whether or not the Garnishee timely filed its answers under a Writ of Execution and Writ of Garnishment, and whether or not pursuant to NRS 31.330 the Garnishee is entitled to a judgment in its favor. Further arguments by Mr. Smith that since the Plaintiff failed to file a reply within 20 days of the Garnishee's answers to Interrogatories, the Plaintiff is deemed to have accepted the answers of the Garnishee as true. Argument by Mr. Welsh regarding whether or not the judgment should be limited to a finding that the answers of the Interrogatories are accepted as true and whether or not any finding or ruling beyond the limits of finding that the answer of the Interrogatories as true are unwarranted. Mr. Lavergne submitted on the arguments of Mr. Smith.

COURT stated it FINDS and CONCLUDES that there is no dispute that the Cosmopolitan timely answered the interrogatories, that it denied owning any debt to, or possessing the property of Defendant and that Plaintiff failed to file a reply or opposition with twenty (20) days and further, NRS 31.330 is applicable. Court further stated pursuant to the language of NRS 31.3330, judgment may be entered. The plain language of the statute allows for judgment, not a limited judgment with

findings only. No case law was cited to support Plaintiff's request. COURT ORDERED, Motion is GRANTED in its entirety. Mr. Smith to prepare, circulate and submit the Order.
