

ORDER TO FILE OPENING BRIEF

On July 12, 2021, the clerk of the court issued a notice directing appellant, among other things, to file and serve, by November 9, 2021, either (1) a brief that complies with NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32 or (2) an informal brief for pro se parties on the form provided by the clerk. The notice cautioned that failure to timely file a brief could result in the dismissal of this appeal. To date, appellant has failed to comply or otherwise communicate with this court.

Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve either (1) an opening brief that complies with NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32 or (2) an informal brief for pro se parties on the form provided by the clerk of the court. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.
