

*ORDER TO FILE OPENING BRIEF*

On July 12, 2021, the clerk of the court issued a notice directing appellant, among other things, to file and serve, by November 9, 2021, either (1) a brief that complies with NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32 or (2) an informal brief for pro se parties on the form provided by the clerk. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.
